**TWENTY ( 20 ) SCHOLARSHIPS**

**\$60,000 IN SCHOLARSHIPS**

**for Knights, Sons and Daughters of Pennsylvania Knights of Columbus and Columbian Squires**

Each candidate must be at least one of the following:

- A paid up member of the Knights of Columbus Council in the jurisdiction of Pennsylvania who has been a member for at least one year from the date of application.
- A son or daughter of a paid up member of a Knights of Columbus Council in Pennsylvania who has been a member for at least one year from the date of application.
- The son or daughter of a deceased member of the Knights of Columbus in a Pennsylvania council who was not in arrears at the time of his death.
- A qualified Columbian Squire

Other conditions that must be met:

- Each candidate must be a practical Catholic.
- The candidate must be a candidate for graduation in a recognized four-year high school, or its equivalent during the term ending January 2009 or June 2009.
- Each candidate must make application for entrance to a College, University or School of Nursing connected with a hospital before accepting the scholarship. Such college or school may be under Catholic or non-Catholic auspices subject to approval by the committee.
- The candidate must file a properly completed application form with the Scholarship Committee of the Pennsylvania State Council of the Knights of Columbus, no later than December 31, 2008. The application must bear all the appropriate signatures as shown on the application.
- The sponsoring council must have fulfilled their requirement for the sale of "Chance of a Lifetime" (C.O.A.L.) Books as distributed by the Pennsylvania State Council Charities Committee for the 2008 campaign.

The candidate in order to compete for a Knights of Columbus Pennsylvania State Scholarship must take two important steps:

1. Complete the application and mail it before December 31, 2008 to:

2. Register with your principal or guidance counselor to take the American College testing (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) to be given in Pennsylvania:

**A.C.T. – September 13, October 25, and December 13, 2008**

**S.A.T. – October 4, November 1, and December 6, 2008**
